HALTON HEALTHCARE is committed to providing high-quality, patient-centred care. However, our community has changed dramatically over the past 25 years since Halton Healthcare was formed.



Halton Region's population is projected to grow by 48% over the next 20 years, which is among the fastest rates of all Ontario regions.

Seniors (aged 75 and older) are the fastest growing segment in our region's population. It is projected to double over the next 20 years.

Our paediatric population is projected to grow by 46% between 2023-2043.

Our community and team are becoming more culturally diverse, underscoring the need to introduce new ways of reaching patients and recruiting and retaining staff from diverse backgrounds to ensure equitable access to care for all.

Our top priority is to make it easier for patients across Halton Region to access the care they need at our hospitals, when they need it.

Given the population shifts and expected increased demand for hospital services, we launched **One Halton Healthcare**, our vision to reimagine how and where we deliver care across our hospital system.

Through One Halton Healthcare, we are planning for the services and care our community needs - both now and in the future. This includes pursuing the redevelopment of the Georgetown Hospital, as well as building more capacity across our three sites, to help reduce hospital wait times and get people the high-quality care they need, faster.

This work is the evolution of what we have always done as a hospital system — put the needs of our community first.

Our Clinical Service Plan was guided by four key principles:

Care Intensification

Expand and enhance existing services to provide more comprehensive care.



Care Closer to Home

Address identified gaps in care to provide access to services closer to home.



Care@Home

Support people to access services in their homes or community.



Care Optimization

Support strategies to manage care in new and more effective ways.



The plan was developed with extensive input and engagement from over 250 hospital staff, physicians, partners and community stakeholders. Over 100 potential initiatives were initially identified, which were then further refined and prioritized based on the following criteria:

- **Patient Outcomes**
- **Community Needs**
- **Patient Experiences** Attracting &
 - **Retaining Talent**
- **Partnerships** Required
- Government Support
- **Fiscal Realities**

A Master Plan is an organizational roadmap, developing a strategy for growth, implementation, cost and schedule across our hospital and community sites over the course of 5, 10, 15, and 20 years. The roadmap will ensure a strategy is in place to maintain a continued level of care, as we look to adapt, expand and respond to the changing needs of the communities we serve.

The Master Plan is a natural evolution to the Clinical Service Plan, as the project will further refine the programmatic needs, as well as where to locate the services. The process develops a strategy for the implementation of each initiative - how, when and where, and prioritizes them based on community/services need.

This plan will not happen overnight. It will take significant effort to think and work creatively together to accomplish these goals, and to garner support from government and our communities that will position Halton Healthcare for success.

Throughout this process, and through all the services we provide, Halton Healthcare remains committed to fostering an equitable, diverse and inclusive environment for patients, families, staff and the communities we serve.

Emergency Services
