INFECTIOUS DISEASES CONSULTANT Oakville - Milton - Georgetown, Ontario

Halton Healthcare is seeking an **Infectious Diseases Consultant** to join the Department of Medicine, Division of Infectious Diseases. Halton Healthcare is a multisite community hospital, with acute care sites at Oakville, Milton, and Georgetown. A growing and aging population, in addition to increased travel and immigration, has created a growing need for infectious diseases services.

The successful candidate will be part of a successful group of infectious diseases specialists based in Oakville, and will be expected to provide at least 11 weeks of inpatient ID consultation service (including associated weekend and evening) multi-site coverage. In addition to inpatient coverage and follow-up of discharged patients, the candidate will be expected to share in outpatient referrals (private office in Oakville, shared with the infectious diseases group). The hospital provides limited clinic space at the Oakville site for outpatient care.

There will be no requirement for internal medicine call coverage or most responsible physician (MRP) coverage of admitted patients. An expansion of virtual care options for inpatient care at the Georgetown site is planned.

Halton Healthcare provides a competitive monthly remuneration for after-hours coverage of IPAC, medical microbiology, in addition to a stipend for participation in the antimicrobial stewardship programme.

Candidates must have an independent license or be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians & Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO). Certification with the Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons of Canada (FRCP(C)) in Internal Medicine or Paediatrics with a Certificate of Special Competence in Infectious Diseases is preferred. Eligibility for Royal College certification in infectious diseases, if training was not undertaken in Canada, will be considered. Interested ID candidates with a Paediatrics background should have extensive experience in adult infectious diseases. Medical Microbiology certification is an asset, but not a requirement for this position.
